24 entered in this action as follows:


25 1. Plaintiffs shall have judgment in their favor on their claims for declaratory
26 relief for federal trademark infringement, federal trademark dilution, and state unfair
27 competition.

1 2. Plaintiffs shall have judgment in their favor on defendant Empire Distribution
2 Inc.'s counterclaims for federal trademark infringement, federal trademark dilution, federal
3 unfair competition, California statutory unfair competition and false advertising, California
4 common law trademark infringement, and California trademark dilution, and defendants
5 shall recover nothing; and

6 3. Plaintiff shall have its costs of suit.

7 The Clerk is ordered to enter this Judgment.
