


Ex parte reexamination Filings

- 1168 filed since 2016
- 62% increase from FY20 to FY21
 - FY20 filings: 168
 - FY21 filings: 273
- 345 currently pending



Ex parte reexamination Timing: Order or denial


- Average time to Order or Denial in FY21:
 - Order (264 cases):1.1 months
 - Denial (13 cases):1.7 months
- Substantial new question of patentability (SNQ) found in 95.3% of cases



Ex parte reexamination


Timing: Notice of Intent to Issue Reexamination Certificate (NIRC)

- Average time to NIRC in FY 2021:
 - 10.6 months for cases without appeals
 - N = 156
 - 15.9 months total for all cases
 - N = 186



Legacy inter partes reexamination


- 27 total pending
 - 11 at CAFC
 - 15 at PTAB
 - 1 at CRU





Supplemental examination (SE) Filings


- 386 filed since inception of AIA in 2012
 - 322granteda filingdate






Supplemental examination (SE) Timing: SNQ determination and issuance of SE Certificate

- Average time to SNQ Determination/ Issuance of SE certificate in FY21:
 - 0.9 months
- SNQ data since inception in 2012:
 - SNQ found 68.5%
 - Found: N = 218
 - Not found: N = 100



SE based reexaminations ordered Timing: Average time to NIRC

- Average time to NIRC in FY21:
 - 9.8 months (without appeal)
 - 15.8 months (total)




