FINAL JUDGMENT ORDER

THIS CAUSE came on for trial upon the pleadings filed by the parties herein and it appearing to the Court that the Jury rendered the following verdict:

As to Count 1 for Misappropriation of Trade Secrets, the jury finds for Plaintiff Appian Corporation against both Defendant Pegasystems Inc. and Defendant Youyong Zou.

As to Count 1, the jury awards damages to Plaintiff Appian Corporation and against Defendant Pegasystems Inc. in the amount of Two Billion Thirty-Six Million Eight Hundred Sixty Thousand Forty-Five U.S. dollars (\$2,036,860,045.00).

As to Count 1, the jury awards damages to Plaintiff Appian Corporation and against Defendant Youyong Zou in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).

As to Count 1, the jury finds willful and malicious misappropriation by Defendant Pegasystems Inc.

As to Count 1, the jury does not find willful and malicious misappropriation by Defendant Youyong Zou.

As to Count 2 for Computer Fraud in Violation of the Computer Crimes Act, the jury finds for Plaintiff Appian Corporation against Defendant Pegasystems Inc.

As to **Count 2**, the jury awards damages to Plaintiff Appian Corporation and against Defendant Pegasystems Inc. in the amount of One Dollar (\$1.00).


Therefore, UPON CONSIDERATION of the verdict of the jury; it is

ADJUDGED and **ORDERED** that judgment be and is hereby entered in favor of Plaintiff Appian Corporation against Defendant Pegasystems Inc. in the amount of Two Billion Thirty-Six Million Eight Hundred Sixty Thousand Forty-Five U.S. dollars (\$2,036,860,045.00) as damages, plus post-judgment interest on those damages at the statutory judgment ^{annual} rate of interest of 6% ~~per annum~~ beginning on May 9, 2022, which amount is \$ _____ as of the date of this Final Judgment Order and continues to accrue; attorney's fees in the amount of \$ 23,615,461.34; and costs in the amount of \$ 3780.07; plus post-judgment interest on those attorneys' fees and costs at the statutory judgment ^{annual} rate of interest of 6% ~~per annum~~ beginning on the date of this Final Judgment Order; and it is further

ADJUDGED and **ORDERED** that judgment be and is hereby entered in favor of Plaintiff Appian Corporation against Defendant Youyong Zou in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) as damages; plus interest at the statutory judgment ^{annual} rate of interest of 6% ~~per annum~~ beginning on May 9, 2022, which amount is \$ _____ as of the date of this Final Judgment Order and continues to accrue.


